Dear East End Prep Families,

As we continue to decipher through these waves of new information and uncertainty about the future, we are committed to communicating with you regularly and transparently about where we are in the planning process. As our planning continues to move fast and flexibly given the timing of new information, please know things may change quickly but again we are committed to keeping you informed every step of the way.

Updates:

- **Food Service:** Below is Metro's plan for providing regular food to students starting March 23rd as long as schools remain closed. **Given the number of families across the county who will be accessing this, we highly recommend that you get to the site closest to your home very early to ensure you are in line and ready.** You can also go to <https://news.mnps.org/mnps-food-delivery-sites-announced/> to view this information on their website.

Starting Monday, March 23, Metro Schools will be offering free breakfast and lunch meals to children in Nashville at locations throughout Davidson County on weekdays. The meals will be bagged or boxed and available in a drive-through setup to limit crowds and possible exposure to COVID-19. The meals will be cold or room temperature to allow for transportation. Meals will be available to anyone under 18, regardless of their school status; however, they must be present to collect the meals, based on federal law. Meals will be prepared at Cane Ridge High School, John Overton High School, and Haynes Middle School and will be delivered to the following locations for pickup between 8- 9 a.m. for breakfast and 12-1:30 p.m. for lunch:

- **Distance Learning week 1:**
 - If you have not already taken the tech survey, please take the survey linked [here](#), and also linked in the EEP website. If you cannot access it, call the front office this week between 8 and 2 to provide your survey answers over the phone.
 - **On Monday, March 23rd grade level packets will be copied and ready for you in the front of the school between the hours of 8:30am and 5:00pm in a sanitized friendly set up. If you pull up and someone is getting their packet, please wait in your car until the person returns to their car. We want to adhere to the social distancing norms set out by the federal government and prevent further spread of the virus.**
 - You will not turn these packets back in, they are just to keep your scholar productive and learning during this 1st week of distance learning and as our team plans future weeks
 - Most of the packets have answer keys but not all of them
 - The packets are designed to be independent for you and your scholar. During this 1st week, your teachers and leaders will be planning what things look like for week 2 and beyond and will not have regular times set up to support. Moving forward into week 2 (March 30th-April 3rd), teachers will be available virtually and via phone at specific daily times during the week. Those times will be communicated in a future update.

- **Communication:** we will continue to update you regularly via the EEP website (www.eastendprep.org) and the East End Prep facebook page. We will also continue to send call outs when new important information is posted. Additionally, you can always call the front office at 630-7470 as front office staff will be available via phone during work days from 8:00-2:00 over spring break and 8:00 to 4:00 after spring break.

Please make sure you are taking care of yourself and your families during these unprecedented times. We are here to support you and the entire East End Prep community every step of the way as we get through this crisis together.
