



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS DURING COVID-19 SCHOOL CLOSURE

Will my child advance to the next grade?

Almost all of our scholars will progress to the next grade. We will work next year to address missed learning opportunities from our current closure. Students will only be retained on a case by case basis. If this applies to your scholar, you will be contacted by administrators in your scholar's grade band.

Will East End Prep have an extended school year since we have been out so long?

The Tennessee Legislature waived the 180 days of annual classroom instruction due to the Coronavirus. Therefore, school systems are not required to make up days missed due to the public health emergency.

My scholar still has personal items in school. When will scholars be able to return to clean out their lockers?

Once Governor Lee's Stay at Home order expires on April 30, we will schedule a time for parents and students to retrieve their belongings beginning the week of May 18. You will receive a specific schedule that will allow our students to maintain social distancing prior to May 18.

I have an East End Prep Chromebook. When am I required to return it?

All Chromebooks must be returned to East End Prep by June 5th to ensure we can get them ready for use for the 20-21 school year. You may drop them off in the front office from 12pm – 1pm from May 27 - June 5.

What about my scholar's grades for the 2019-2020 school year?

In the last few weeks, you should have received an email with your scholar's Quarter 3 report card grades. Please email EastEndPrepReportCards@eastendprep.org if you did not receive your scholar's quarter 3 grades. Please list your scholar's first and last name and grade level in the body of the email. Also, the email address that you send the email from should be one you check regularly and have easy access to, as grades will be sent to it.

What about end-of-year activities such as the Athletic Banquet, grade level celebrations, and 8th grade graduation?

All end-of-year activities (including K-8 grade level recognitions) will happen virtually. Please refer to the EEP website and social media pages to learn more of the specifics. 8th



Grade Graduation will be **postponed**. We will continuously communicate about all of these special events. The EEP Athletic Banquet is scheduled for May 15 on social media.

What about yearbooks?

We will distribute at the start of the 20-21 school year. We will contact 8th grade scholars individually in the Fall about picking up their yearbook.

What about TN Ready?

No state assessments will be given this school year.

Will my scholar have work to do over the summer?

Each grade level will offer guidance for optional summer work including packets, online resources, and reading materials. This is not required but encouraged to ensure we alleviate as much of the summer slide as possible.

We are taking our Distance Learning Plan for EEP Middle Schoolers live! Going forward all scholars will complete 2 assignments from each core content area, 1 of which will be a live lesson where scholars should log on to participate in a virtual learning experience facilitated by their teachers. The links for the virtual lessons will be posted to your scholar's google classroom webpage. Live lessons will start on Monday, May 4th and proceed through the end of the school year.

School wide (K-8), distance learning will continue until May 22, our last day of school.

School Lunches

Free breakfast and lunch will be available to anyone 18 and under, regardless of their school status; every weekday that schools are closed. Students should be present to collect the meals or parents will be asked to provide information to verify that the meals are for children 18 and under. The bagged or boxed meals will be provided in a drive-through setup. Please check the MNPS website for locations.

Will we be able to finish spring sports?

The TSSAA has announced that all Spring sports are canceled for the remainder of the school year.

What about tryouts for next year's sports teams?

Tryouts for fall sports teams will happen when we return for the 20-21 school year.

What about the required physicals needed to participate?

Our plan is to have all physicals completed by early August. We are hopeful to have our sponsor come to the school to offer physicals on site. As a reminder, physicals are good for one calendar year so if your scholar received a physical in October to play basketball, the same physical can be used for fall sports.

What about Drama Club's production of High School Musical?

Coach Jones has created a movie for our spring Disney production, High School Musical. A link will be sent out on May 18.

Will there be summer opportunities for sport camps and performing arts camps?
